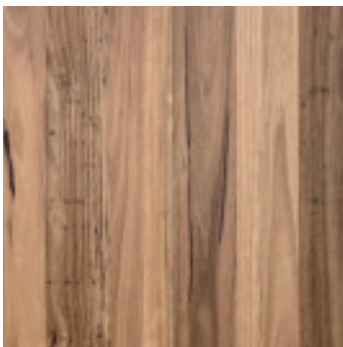

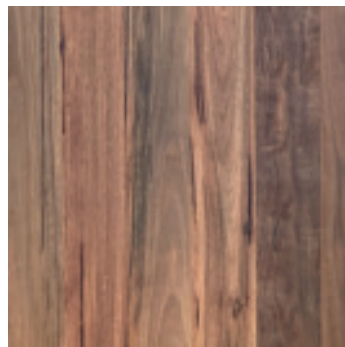

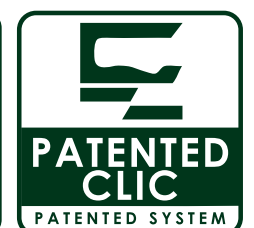

- Excessive heat, sunlight, extreme humidity can have an effect on your timber flooring. All precautions including awnings, tinted windows, curtains, humidifiers etc should be used to maintain a habitable environment for your timber floor.
